

S&M Young Researcher Paper Award 2017

Outline:

The S&M Young Researcher Paper Award is presented to a young researcher aged less than 40 years as of the date of submission and who has contributed an outstanding paper to *Sensors and Materials* with the aim of promoting submission from young researchers in the field of sensors and their related materials and technologies.

Jury:

Editors of *Sensors and Materials*

Criteria:

The papers of the award nominees must satisfy the following criteria:

- a. The paper must be published in the issues in 2017 (Vol. 29, Nos. 1–12).
- b. The first author of the paper must be younger than 40 years as of the date of submission.
- c. The review results of two reviewers were both very high in the first review process.
- d. The quality of English is excellent (as judged by proofreaders of the Editorial Department).

Number of award recipients:

Basically, only one may receive the award. If there are no papers that satisfy the above criteria, no one will be selected for the Award for the year.

Announcement:

The Editorial Department notifies the recipient of the S&M Young Researcher Paper Award early in the year. The name of the award recipient is announced on the journal website. (<http://www.myu-inc.jp/myukk/S&M/>)

Award:

The award recipient receives a monetary award of JPY 50000 and the printed copies of *Sensors and Materials* Vol. 30, Nos. 1–12 for his/her outstanding scientific accomplishment.
