Sensors and Materials — Instructions to Authors

1. Types of Manuscript

Contributions should be specified as research papers, review papers, technical papers, perspectives, or letters. Topics to be covered include physical/mechanical sensors, bio/chemical sensors, materials, related technologies, and sensor applications.

2. Policies

Manuscripts submitted to this journal must not have been previously published or be currently under consideration for publication elsewhere. The authors of an accepted manuscript shall agree to transfer the copyright of the manuscript to MYU K.K. All papers published in *Sensors and Materials* in 2019 and later are available under the terms of the Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International License (CC-BY 4.0). Any further distribution of the work in *Sensors and Materials* must display *Sensors and Materials*, volume no., page no., and digital object identifier (DOI). For papers published in *Sensors and Materials* in 2018 and earlier, the authors of an accepted paper are required to submit a permission request form to the Editorial Department before publishing its PDF file on their own academic website.

3. Review

All manuscripts must be reviewed by two reviewers recommended by the Editor(s) (for general contributed manuscripts) or Guest Editor(s) (for Instructions to Authors / Sensors and Materials

manuscripts submitted to special issues). The final decision (accept/reject) regarding the manuscript is made by the Editor(s) or Guest Editor(s).

4. Fees

The authors are obliged to pay the following fees.

4.1 Publication fee

The authors are obliged to pay the publication fee determined in accordance with the number of pages published in *Sensors and Materials*.

4.2 Proofreading fee

After submission, all manuscripts will be subject to our English proofreading service. If the quality of the English of the manuscript does not satisfy the journal standards, the authors must bear the proofreading fee (JPY 11000–44000, depending on the amount of corrections), which will be charged with the publication fee.

4.3 Color printing fee

Color figures will be published as they are in the electronic version but will be printed in black and white in the printed version of the journal and reprints. If you prefer color figures in the printed version, a supplemental fee will be charged (JPY 22000 per color page).

4.4 Reprints

If you request reprints, you will be obliged to pay an additional fee (for example, 30 copies of a 10-page paper: JPY 11000).

5. Withdrawal

A manuscript once accepted for publication should not be withdrawn without special reason. If the authors withdraw their manuscript once it has been accepted, the authors must pay the cancellation fee, which will be determined in accordance with when the authors informed us of the cancellation. 6. PDF

The payment of the publication fee entitles you to a PDF file of your paper free of charge.

7. Use of Figures

Authors must obtain formal permission from relevant publishers to use figures and tables taken from already published papers. The reference numbers should be appropriately given in the body of the text and in the figure or table caption to clarify the source.

8. Use of Human-derived Samples

Authors are required to describe in their manuscripts that they have obtained formal approval from the appropriate ethical committee and how consent was obtained from participants when the research involves human

participants and human-derived samples.
